Following the successful conversion of a former motel, MCCAC's Gloria Center Annex is now operational, offering safe, accessible housing for houseless clients from Hood River, Wasco, and Sherman counties.

The Annex provides over 50 transitional housing and shelter units with coordinated supportive services integrated on-site in collaboration with community partners.

Transitional Housing & Shelter

Our facility includes over 50 units of transitional housing and shelter, including units suitable for families, ADA-accessible units, units dedicated to veterans, and units dedicated to clients working with culturally responsive organizations.

Services at The Annex

At The Annex, clients can access an array of supportive services including culturally responsive case management, Oregon Health Plan enrollment, food stamps enrollment, healthcare, behavioral healthcare, respite medical care, jail diversion programming, employment resources, and rapid rehousing resources.

The Annex's goals center around stabilizing individuals and families, connecting them to supportive services that will help them to access and maintain long-term, stable housing. The facility is staffed 24/7 with a property manager living on site.
